Math Olympiad is Math Problem solving contests for teams of up to 35 students in grades 4 through 8. Mission Valley will have several teams. It is open only to schools, home schools, and institutes (NOT INDIVIDUALS).

Math Olympiad is organized into 2 divisions -

Div E (Elem.) : For grades 4-6

Div M(Middle) : For grade 6+

There are total 5 contests, one each month starting November of the school year thru March.
