MEDICATIONS AT SCHOOL/END OF SCHOOL YEAR 18/19-

All medication and supplies ***must be picked up from the school office on the last day of school!*** Medications must be picked up by a parent or guardian. Medication not picked up will be disposed.

Summer School Medications-

- If attending summer school, the medication and accompanying doctor's order must be picked up the last day of school from your student's current school site.
- Parent/guardian is required to take their student's medication to the summer school site on the first day. Verify the medication does not expire prior to July 31, 2019.
- Parent/guardian pick-up medications on the last day of summer school.

Very Important-Students Must Attend School on the first day, Wednesday, August 28, 2019

The 2019/2020 School Year begins on Wednesday, August 28, 2019. **All students are expected to report to school on the first day, Wednesday, August 28, 2019, unless they are ill. Students who have not attended the first day of school may be transferred to another school effective the second day of school if classrooms at the school of original enrollment are filled.** Parents must call in their child's absence and notify the school that their child is ill in order to save their seat. **Seats will not be held for students on extended vacations or other optional activities, whether or not the school is notified.**

Info for Incoming Kindergarten Parents

The kinder schedule for the 2019/2020 school year will not be posted. Each parent of an incoming kinder will receive a letter in the mail that will list whether your child is in the AM or PM class. These letters will be sent home at the end of June to give families time to arrange drop off, pick up and/or daycare. Because of space constraints and demand, we are unable to take any requests for AM or PM schedule.
