Do You Have Medication in the Office?

Maze Day

We will be holding our Maze Day on Tuesday, August 28 from 8:15-11:30am and 12:45pm-3:15pm. You can come any time during these hours. We will be closed for lunch from 11:30am-12:45pm. The purpose of Maze Day is to give out classroom assignments to parents in a confidential way (rather than posting them). Also, school staff will receive all the important paperwork needed prior to school starting. When you return your completed paperwork, you will receive your child's class assignment!

A parent or legal guardian must be present in order to receive the classroom assignment. We will not take any paperwork or give out classroom assignments outside of the times listed above, so please schedule your vacation and work plans around the schedule listed above. Any families that cannot attend Maze Day will need to go to the office at 8am on the first day of school to turn in paperwork and receive their classroom assignment. If there is a large number of people we need to help at this time, it may cause your child to be late on their first day of school so please try to attend the Maze Day. Due to the nature of the event, we ask that you leave your child at home if possible. If you have any questions, you can contact the office or stop by on or after August 21st.

You will receive all the necessary forms via US Mail about a week before school starts so be on the lookout for mail from Fremont Unified School District!

Attendance on First Day of School, 2018-19

The 2018-19 School Year begins on Wednesday, August 29, 2018. **All students are expected to report to school on the first day, Wednesday, August 29, 2018, unless they are ill. Students who have not attended the first day of school may be transferred to another school effective the second day of school if classrooms at the school of original enrollment are filled.** Parents must call in their child's absence and notify the school that their child is ill in order to save their seat. **Seats will not be held for students on extended vacations or other optional activities, whether or not the school is notified.**

Info for Incoming Kinder Parents

Kinder schedule for the 2018-19 school year will not be posted. Each parent of incoming kinders will receive a letter in the mail that will list whether your child is in the AM or PM class. These letters will be sent home at the end of June.

Because of space constraints and demand we are unable to take any requests for AM or PM schedule.

Classroom assignments will be given out on Maze Day. There will also be a brief Kinder Sneak Peek for kinder students and their parents from 1pm – 2pm in the kinder rooms (1, K1, K2).

Not Attending the Last Day of School?

If you are planning on leaving for vacation before the end of the school year, please make sure you report the absence to the office.

Make sure you touch base with your teacher as well to gather any school supplies that should be going home with your child. The office does not store any school supplies, school work, etc. over the summer. Anything left will be donated.

Report cards will not be mailed home to students not attending the last day of school. Parents will need to pick them up in the office when we reopen on August 20.
